DART Police Telecommunicators are responsible for receiving requests for police services, dispatching calls for service to DART Police Officers over a two-way radio and computer, processing requests for assistance from DART Police Officers, monitoring police radio transmissions, and processing requests through the Texas Law Enforcement Telecommunications System.



Minimum Qualifications

- 19 years of age
- U.S. citizen or legally authorized to work in U.S.
- High School Diploma or G.E.D.
- Honorable Discharge from Military
- No Felony convictions
- No Class A Misdemeanor convictions
- No Class B Misdemeanor convictions in the last 10 years
- No pending criminal investigations or actions
