Construction Update



The DART Orange Line construction is quickly moving along the corridor and into the North Lake College area. Construction activities will be in preparation for the light rail system that will extend from downtown Dallas, through Las Colinas, and eventually connect to the DFW airport. Beginning the week of May 24, expect heavy construction activity to move into the North Lake College area. Operations will include grading, roadway reconfiguration, utility work, station work, and heavy truck and equipment traffic. In an attempt to minimize these traffic impacts some night work may be required.

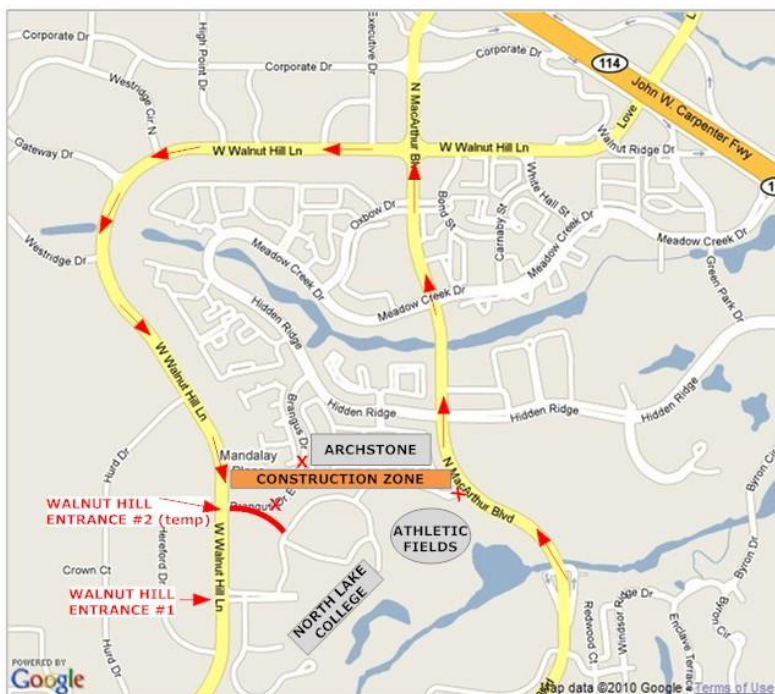
This heavy activity is expected to continue through Fall 2010.

In an attempt to minimize impacts, weekly construction updates are emailed out. This helps provide a more definitive answer to many construction questions, and provides notice to areas that may experience upcoming traffic delays or construction activity.
