

Purpose of Today's Briefing

• The committee will be briefed on the status of the five-year professional services pool contract, initial authorized amount for two-year period (FY 20 and FY 21), amount spent to date, and next steps for consideration to increase value of contract to include FY 22.



Background

On September 24, 2019, the DART Board of Directors approved a resolution authorizing the President/Executive Director or his designee to:

- Establish contracts for Professional Services Pool to provide engineering and architectural design services, surveying, construction management, and other capital project support services
- Award a five-year contract to each of the selected firms
- Amount not to exceed \$43,747,200 for two-year period,
 FY20 and FY21

Next Steps

- Although an increase to value of contract is needed for remaining 3 years (FY 22, FY 23, and FY 24) to maintain continuity of support for ongoing capital projects and upcoming projects approved in the financial plan, a 2-step plan is recommended
- On August 10, 2021, consideration of increase to value of contract for FY22 including capital project support of federal process for entry into engineering and grant application for D2 Subway Project
- In March 2022, consideration of increase to value of contract for FY23 and FY24, including D2 Subway Project if approved
